Santiam Canyon Stampede Pageant Expectations & Responsibilities

Upon winning the title of **Miss Santiam Canyon Stampede**, the titleholder becomes the official representative for the **Santiam Canyon Stampede**, and as such is responsible to represent the sport of rodeo in its true light to the general public. She must strive to represent exceptional sportsmanship, high moral, ethical character, and humane treatment of animals. She is expected to act, speak and dress according to the esteem the title deserves anytime she is in the public eye. As riding and horsemanship skills are key to the promotion of the sport of rodeo, we encourage striving to improve those skills.

- ❖ Contestant shall be at least 18 to 24 years of age – you will be asked to provide proof of age at orientation.
- ❖ Contestant must reside (permanent address) within a 70 - mile radius of Stayton or Sublimity during the term of her reign.
- ❖ Contestant shall not be married or engaged or become married or engaged during her reign. Contestant shall not be, nor become pregnant during her reign, or have had children previous to trying out.
- ❖ Contestant must be either enrolled in high school or have successfully completed high school with a diploma or the equivalent.
- ❖ The titleholder must have her own horse or full lease of one during her reign. It is the responsibility of the titleholder and/or her family to provide their own transportation of the horse and have all necessary items for the required appearances. The titleholder must have all tack and apparel in showmanship condition. The titleholder must be properly groomed and attired for all appearances.
- ❖ **The equipment and horse applicant rides must be the same for the contest as that used during her reign**, except by special permission of the Santiam Canyon Stampede. Only one horse is required, but a back-up horse is recommended in case the original horse cannot finish out the season, or is not suitable for a certain function. The Santiam Canyon Stampede Board reserves the right to require the Queen to ride another mount if her horse is deemed unsuitable.
- ❖ Contestants must have knowledge of the Santiam Canyon Stampede area as well as the Santiam Canyon Stampede and activities associated with it. As the titleholder you would be representing ALL of those things.
- ❖ Previous Queens of the Santiam Canyon Stampede are not eligible.
- ❖ Official duties **MUST** come first throughout the reign – this includes work schedules, school schedules and vacations. The Queen’s advisor along with the Santiam Canyon Stampede Board, must approve exceptions. We will try to make every effort to cooperate within reason. **NOTE:** please see the included tentative schedule for 2006 appearances.
- ❖ As the titleholder, she would be expected to conduct herself properly at all times. Any conduct displayed by the Santiam Canyon Stampede Queen that is detrimental to the title or Rodeo will result in

automatic disqualification and/or dismissal. NO drinking of alcoholic beverages, smoking of cigarettes, foul language, or drugs will be allowed. REMEMBER, the first impression is most often the most memorable and appearance will be judged by others at all times.

- ❖ As Queen, the titleholder must be on time to all functions set up for her.
- ❖ If the selected Queen is unable to fulfill her position after being selected, the Santiam Canyon Stampede Board reserves the right to determine if the position will be replaced or remain vacant.
- ❖ The chosen Queen will be expected to fulfill the position, which officially starts January 1st, 2006.
- ❖ The position of Queen will require attendance at riding events, parades, speaking engagements, meetings, elementary school visits, festivals and public appearances.
- ❖ The Santiam Canyon Stampede Board will approve scheduled appearances. Whenever possible, appearances within the Santiam Canyon area will take precedence over out of the area functions. The Queen is welcome to suggest possible appearances and functions to attend.
- ❖ As titleholder it is her responsibility to wear her crown and sash any time she is acting in her official capacity. She should always make sure her clothing is clean and pressed, hat blocked and cleaned, and wear appropriate dress for the occasion. All clothing must be western in style and approved by the Royalty Advisor if not assigned by them.

***Radio Station** – Approved/assigned western style dress outfit & jewelry.

***Luncheons** – Approved/assigned western style dress outfit & jewelry.

***Parades** – Approved/assigned parade outfit that includes western style jeans, a form fitting long sleeve western style blouse, chaps, western style boots & jewelry.

***Rodeo Grand Entry** – Approved/assigned arena outfit that includes western style jeans, a form fitting long sleeve western style blouse, chaps, western style boots & jewelry.

***School Appearances** - Approved/assigned outfit that includes western style jeans, a form fitting long sleeve western style blouse, western style boots & jewelry.

***Evening Meal Gatherings** - Approved/assigned western style dress outfit & jewelry.

***Special circumstances** – the Royalty Advisor may approve a casual assigned outfit that includes an embroidered polo with western jeans & boots.

- ❖ Failure to abide by all the rules given to the new Queen will result in:

Relinquishing and returning all awards, clothing, tack, accessories, pay any damages, and pay for replacement clothing within 30 days. If this is not fulfilled, she will owe the Santiam Canyon stampede a cash amount equal to the retail value of her awards.

I have read and understand the expectations of holding the title of 2006 Miss Santiam Canyon Stampede and agree to uphold them if chosen as Queen.
